#### **GETTING TO UNDERCOVER:**

Everyone is asked to try and get to the festival if you can by public transport, taxi or car share.

ADMITTANCE is by advance ticket ONLY, no tickets will be available at the festival site for sale "on the door", but if any tickets are left then they will be available online only up to 9pm each day.

# WHAT ARE THE OPENING / CLOSING / RE-ENTRY TIMES:

In order to manage the site effectively and in a safe manner no admittance or readmittance after 9pm each day.

Campsite access (see right) ... ...

Friday 26<sup>th</sup> Sept 2025: Doors: 2.30pm // First band on 3:15pm

Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> Sept 2025: Doors: 12 mid day // First band on 12:45pm

ON ARRIVAL: have your tickets (paper and online) ready at ticket exchange, if in a car you may be directed to the car park and then asked to walk back to ticket exchange.

CARS: While on site to parking please keep your speed to no more than 5mph and have your hazard lights on.

#### CAMPING AND CAMPERVANS

Campsite is accessible for 2 day ticket holders only from 10.30am on the 26th.

On arrival you will be directed to the campsite. No cars will be permitted on the campsite, so you will have to park up and unload.

Please no camping in the middle as we need to keep that clear for emergency vehicle access.

Ideally campervans should be on site if at all possible before mid day 26th), campervans are asked to drive no faster that 5 mph and have hazard lights on when driving through the campsite to set up.

NO access to setting up camping on the Saturday as camping is for 2 day ticket holders only.

This is necessary so that the site can be managed safely.

NO FIRES OR BBQS ARE PERMITTED ON THE CAMPSITE.

PLEASE NOTE: While there are shops a short driving distance away there are none on site for general groceries.

STAYING ON SITE BEFORE OR AFTER THE FESTIVAL: If you have a 2 day ticket for the festival camping / campervans is part of the ticket for the Friday and Saturday nights other nights you will have to book through the venue.











The Skids were formed in the summer of 1977 in Dunfermline Scotland and would go on to make 2 albums and seven singles before 1979 was ended,

and all bar one on the Virgin label. Arguably the biggest Scottish punk band of the 1976-79 era, their most successful year was 1979 where they spent over half the year in the singles charts with hits like Charade, Working For The Yankee Dollar and their biggest song, the top 10 hit Into The Valley. 
